BOSSIER PARISH SCHOOL SYSTEM

The Bossier Parish School System was established in 1890. The system has a total of 6 high schools. It currently serves a student population of approximately 22,000.

POPULATION AND COMMUNITY

Established in 1964, Airline is a neighborhood public high school composed of 1,900 students in grades 9-12. With over 100 classroom teachers, four full-time administrators, four full time counselors and one part time counselor, and two School Resource Officers, Airline serves a diverse student body.

ACCREDITATION

Airline is accredited by the Louisiana Department of Education and approved by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must earn 24 Carnegie units <u>and</u> pass a series of LEAP exams in English Language Arts, Mathematics and <u>either</u> Science or Social Studies.

CURRICULUM AND SCHEDULE

Programs of study are organized on three levels: Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment and General. AP and DE level students enroll in a college preparatory curriculum based on ability and aptitude. Currently eleven APcourses and five DE courses are offered. General level students may be involved in vocational training as well as the required academic courses. The school day consists of four 90-minute periods on a 4x4 Block Schedule. Students earn 1 Carnegie unit for each semester course successfully completed, a total of 8 credits per year.

GRADING SCALE AND CLASS RANK

All students are ranked with the weighted 4 point grading scale at the end of each semester. All courses and grades are considered in the class rank. AP and DE courses are awarded the same number of quality points in determining rank and GPA.
